General Information

Invitation

The Styrian Chess Federation is pleased to invite your federation to participate in the **22nd European Union Youth Chess Championship 2025**, to be held in Mureck.

Participation

Each federation may register one player (boy or girl) for each of the following age groups: U8, U10, U12, U14 (date of birth reference: January 1, 2025).

Additional players (extra players) may also be registered.

Eligible to participate are all citizens of an EU or Schengen state, as well as Ukraine and Kosovo. The organizers do not provide support for visa applications.

Important:

All participants (players, parents, coaches, and accompanying persons) must stay in the officially designated accommodations arranged by the Organizing Committee. Direct bookings are not allowed. If accommodations are booked independently, an additional organizational fee of \in 80 must be paid in advance.

Registration and participation conditions

Registration deadline: June 15, 2025 (early registration is recommended).

The registration must include:

First name(s) and surname(s), Date of birth and FIDE ID of each player Telephone number and email address of all participants (including accompanying persons).

Please use the provided registration form and submit it via email to the organizer. Travel expenses are the responsibility of the participants or their respective federations.

Participation fee:

Each player (whether invited or extra) and one invited coach must pay \in 100 in advance to the organizing committee.

Final acceptance of registration is subject to the timely receipt of all payments.

Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be provided in Mureck and the surrounding area. If a federation registers at least two players, the invited players (one per category) and one coach receive free double- or triple-room (or apartment) accommodation with breakfast from Friday, August 1 to Saturday, August 9, 2025.

All payments must be made via bank transfer (in euros only), by June 15, 2025, based on the proforma invoice.

The organizers make every effort to accommodate everyone as satisfactorily as possible and as close to the venue as possible. We are aware that the accommodation situation in Mureck can be challenging and therefore kindly request that you contact us as early as possible. If you have special requirements – such as higher standards or a preference for self-catering accommodations – please let us know. We will do our best to find a suitable option and adjust the prices accordingly.

Standard accommodation:

Rules and regulations

The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds. National ratings will not be taken into consideration for the pairings.

The time control will be 90 minutes for the entire game plus 30 seconds increment per move, starting from move one.

Boys and girls in each category play in the same tournament but are ranked separately. The tournament is rated int. Elo (FIDE Rating)

The tiebreak will be

- (1) Buchholz cut -1
- (2) Buchholz
- (3) Sonneborn-Berger
- (4) greater number of wins

Default time is 15 minutes for each round.

The players cannot draw a game by agreement before black's 30th move. A claim for a draw before black's 30th move is permitted only through the arbiters in the cases of perpetual check or threefold repetition.

The organizer reserves the right to combine groups if a group has fewer than 16 players.

Prizes

The top three players in each group will be awarded trophies The top three girls in each group will be awarded separately with trophies
